

We look forward to an inspiring evening filled with literary insights and personal storytelling. All members are cordially invited to join this enriching experience.


































AGM MEETING



UNDERSTANDING HEART VALVE DISEASE

Heart Valve Disease affects how blood flows through the heart. While less discussed than heart attacks, valve problems can lead to heart failure, stroke or sudden cardiac death if left untreated.

What Are Heart Valves?

The heart has four valves that open and close with each heartbeat, ensuring blood flows in the right direction. Valve disease occurs when one or more valves do not open fully (stenosis) or leak (regurgitation).

Common Types

- Aortic Stenosis: Narrowing of the aortic valve, often due to age-related calcification.
- Mitral Regurgitation: The mitral valve leaks, allowing blood to flow backward into the lungs.
- Tricuspid or Pulmonary Valve Disease: Less common, but still impactful in certain conditions.

Warning Signs

- Shortness of breath during activity or when lying flat
- Fatigue and weakness
- Chest discomfort or palpitations
- Swelling in the legs or feet
- Dizziness or fainting

Diagnosis and Treatment

Valve disease is often diagnosed using a stethoscope (heart murmur), echocardiogram (ultrasound), or advanced imaging. Treatment options include:

- Medications to manage symptoms (e.g., diuretics, beta-blockers)
- Valve Repair or Replacement via surgery or minimally invasive catheter-based procedures (TAVR/MitraClip)

Prevention and Monitoring

- Control blood pressure and avoid rheumatic fever (especially in younger populations)
- Regular heart check-ups if you have a murmur or symptoms
- Early intervention can prevent complications like heart failure

Key Message: Heart valve disease is treatable when caught early. Don't ignore unexplained fatigue, breathlessness, or murmurs.
